Tips:

- **Suggestion + acceptance:**
The first part is not a question, so can't be answered with yes / no.
- **Wh-** questions cannot be answered with yes / no.
For example, 'where' needs to be answered with a place.
- **Matching** auxiliary verbs and tenses:

- (do / do)	- (did / didn't)
- (have got / have)	- (are / am)
