These are some example questions that the candidates might be asked. Always have them respond in full sentence answers.

Travel

- Do you enjoy long journeys? (What do you do to pass the time?)
- Do you have to travel far every day? (Where do you have to go?)
- Do you prefer to travel by car or public transport? (Why?)
- Tell us about an interesting place you've travelled to.

Study or work

- What good memories do you have of school?
- Is there anything you would like to study in the future? (Why?)
- Have you ever had a part-time job? (What do/did you do? Do/did you enjoy it?)
- Would you prefer to work for a big or small company? (Why?)

Sports and hobbies

- Do you prefer individual sports or team sports? (Why?)
- Which is the most popular sport in your country? (Why do you think it's popular?)
- How much time do you spend listening to music? (What kind of music do you like?)
- Do you enjoy playing computer games in your free time? (Why?/Why not?)

Fashion

- Do you think fashion should be an important part in the lives of young people? (Why?/Why not?)
- Do you think people spend too much money on trying to look good? (Why?/Why not?)
- How do you think trends have changed over time? (How do you feel about these changes?)
- Tell us about the impact fashion has on your own life.

Social Media

- Is social media a good or bad thing in general? (Why do you think this?)
- Do you think teenagers spend too much time on social media? (Why?/Why not?)
- How have people's attitudes towards social media changed in recent times?
- Tell us about the way you prefer to use social media.

Politics

- Do you think it is important for young people to be engaged in politics? (Why? Why not?)
- Should children above a certain age have a compulsory politics lesson at school? (Why? Why not?)
- Do you think people should trust politicians? (Why? Why not?)
- How do you feel about the political situation in your country? (Why do you feel like this?)
